



Screen South Create Converge Activity Report June 18 - November 18

Overview

The Screen South team continues to develop and deliver Create Converge opportunities and leads on Work Package 5 as well as contributing to other work packages. Activity across all key deliverables is going well and international exchanges and sharing of the Screen South team activity has taken place with more transnational opportunities are being planned for April 19 and beyond. Screen South organised and took part in activities across skills training, talent progression, showcasing and promotion. We are building international partnerships, sharing knowledge and influencing strategy. The Screen South team has taken part in all transnational partnership meetings, work package meetings and conference calls. Project Leader, Jo Nolan continues to develop and support regional digital talent cohort who are keen to work at a transnational level. Jo Nolan continues to Chair the Creative and Media Guild for Kent and has been feeding VR & Immersive New technology opportunities and development into Kent Skills activities. Create Converge work is having a direct influence on understanding the need for skills development in immersive technologies across the wider sectors. Esther Fox leads on Create Converge Accentuate projects in particular the interactive projects with the heritage sector. Barbara Welch and Stephanie Adamou continue to provide excellent admin and project support and regularly take part in partnership conference calls. Darrienne Price oversees all finance and administration activities and provides back up across all areas to Jo Nolan.

Recent work includes promotion of talent through our Random Acts and C4 partnership and our Accentuate Games development work with museums and heritage sector amongst others. We are planning to bring Esther to Arhus in April to present eth work she has been doing in Interactive in heritage and seek a transnational consultation on her next VR project focused n Genetics

Jo Nolan has attended the Hamburg partnership meeting and worked with the team from Filmforderung Hamburg Schleswig-Holstein to present a VR Masterclass - "Immersive Technology as a Punk Movement" with Simon Wilkinson who has been working across several Screen South interactive projects. She also attended VR conference as part of the AHRC Creative Cluster programme in the UK and continues to share the Create Converge knowledge. The Screen South team keep in regular contact with all partners via email and phone. The team are also planning effective and realistic partnership opportunities for our digital communities in a transnational setting with CC partners.

We have been working with the BBC and Arts Council to develop another new Talent development project and have secured new programme which includes animation audio and interactive technologies.

Project Activities

Creative and Media Skills Guild

Jo Nolan, MD of Screen South continues to Chair of the Kent and Medway Creative Media Skills Guild. She has bought new digital partners into the skills panel including 360 video and VR companies. This is to ensure these areas are included in on-going skills strategies and procurement opportunities. She has also led a collaborative bid to producer interactive careers material across Engineering, Creative and hospitality industries,

Accentuate History of Place

Screen South has been delivering the final stages of the interactive heritage programme and will be presenting the programme and recommendations for managing significant Heritage projects with a a particular emphasis on access for all.

Simon Wilkinson from Circa69 has been leading our interactive games elements work and has delivered 2 games alongside advising and delivering 2 games for the project. Jo Nolan and Simon presented this work in Hamburg as part of the Create Converge Partnership meeting in October 18 and also delivered a Masterclass on Interactive and immersive work. Esther Fox continues leading the overall AHOP programme with Project Management support across games with Paul Homer and John Norton facilitating the Interactive workshops.

Chiswick House Game Development Workshops Chiswick House

We completed the Chiswick House game and launched with a live interactive day 28 October 2018 at the historic house. The called **Dear Drennan** is based on the journey of patient at the house when it was a mental health hospital. Maison Dieu Game Development Workshops

Following a consultation with Circa 69 and researchers highlighting access to source material, it was agreed that the story of Helen, a blind woman who was admitted to Maison Dieu as a serving sister to care for pilgrims on their way to Canterbury shortly after 1234 would be the central narrative of the game. The game was launched at the Canterbury Pageant in July 2018




Exhibition Films and Audio

VR workshops

Esther Fox & Jo Nolan continue to develop a VR experience or interactive Game that will be a playful immersive experience to explore some of the key ethical issues associated with genetic screening. We will be presenting a transitional consultation workshop in Arhus in April

The System Decides: A Gattaca-like austere and bureaucratic near future of humans and Al. The fate of an individual at birth is determined by a system based on genetic screening. People play different roles. ...

Specimen Collector: A multiplayer puzzle game about collecting set in the Victorian era. Your role is to complete your collection of precious specimens by gathering, exchanging, discarding, buying or stealing..

Biomorphs – Seed or Weed? : A multiplayer VR experience where you have to spot the 'weeds' from the 'seeds' which both look very similar.

AHRC Creative Clusters Partnership Bid/ Industrial Strategy Funding

Screen South was successful in bringing the Create Converge agenda to a new Creative Clusters programme -Future Storytelling - a partnership with Royal Holloway University, National film School and other media companies. Jo Nolan is working to support networking an VR company support.

Astrid Goldsmith - Quarantine - BBC Animation Commission

Jo Nolan produced the short animation film quarantine and provided technical advice and guidance with industry mentors. Particularly around Green Screen and tracking for Stop frame animation.

Quarantine, a 13 minute stop-motion animation, exploring the fears that drive anti immigrant rhetoric - and the benefits of cross-cultural exchange - viewed through the lens of British folk tradition. Although set in the modern day, the tone and style of the film will be reminiscent of mid-century folk horror/Hammer films (eg. *The Wicker Man, Witchfinder General*), with richly saturated colours and an ominous, thrilling score.

Screen South is working with the BBC and Arts Council England to deliver the New Creatives commission opportunity to showcase South East regional talent as part of a new national programme. This groundbreaking initiative will offer new digital commissions to over 100 new and emerging Artists and Digital Creatives across the South East aged 16-30 to realise their ideas in high-quality new digital projects that reflect the diverse voice of young people from range of creative disciplines. We will work with Create Converge partners on the VR ad AR element of the programme . Prof. Peter Richardson from Herts University will lead the CC contribution to the programme as Exec Producer on our In **interactive commissions**, we're interested in supporting interesting concepts and ideas for immersive audio and video works that can give an insight into a powerful experience, situation or location. These may be 360 online videos, or binaural audio trails in physical spaces, VR AR ideas

or venue based VR. We are looking for experimental pieces that explore what new technologies offer in this arena..
