Sustainable protein - from BSF larvae fed with residue biomass from Guldborgsund

After screening local biomass for fat, protein, carbohydrate and ash contents, 4 "menues" have been fed to Black Soldier Fly larvae in order to select the best, for 2 larger pilot batches producing minimum 3 kg larvae each. The larvae from the pilot test will be processed and the protein ready to be formulated and fed to fish in order to see if the fish likes the taste – and if the protein is suitable for fish feed.
