Energy Technological Development and Demonstration Program

With support from EUDP, it is possible to conduct projects with experimental development and testing of a technology, system or method under reality-like conditions and thereafter introducing it to market. EUDP offers funding for the development and/or demonstration of all types of energy technology contributing to Managed by: The Danish Energy Agency.

Environmental Technology Development Program

The MUDP supports the development of technologies, processes and/or services within environmental technology. MUDP supports projects within eight primary areas: Water, climate adjustment, circular economy and the re-use of resources in waste, cleaner air, less noise, fewer problematic chemicals, industrial nmental efforts, and ecological construction.
