

EMPOWER 2.0 Declaration

In the Interreg NSR project EMPOWER2.0 partners have to demonstrated on how to accelerate the empowerment of citizens to become active energy citizens. This has led to an increase of energy awareness and renewable energy production, and hence has reduced the environmental footprint in the North Sea Region.

Local and regional authorities can actively contribute to further lower the threshold for citizens to start energy communities. To accomplish this, it is recommended to¹:

- 1. Actively reach out to citizens and communities to inform them via a variety of channels, taking care to leave no one behind in the possibilities for a sustainable transition to green energy and self-efficacy.
- 2. Facilitate access to reliable and independent platforms for information on technical solutions, such as the EMPOWER2.0 toolkit.
- 3. Reduce the administrative burden for permits for small local energy initiatives.
- 4. Lower financial thresholds for instance by supporting in required start-up capital or providing small funding opportunities
